



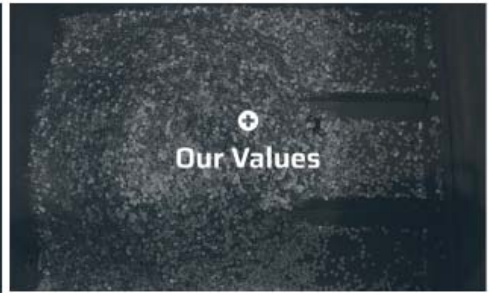

Our Environmental Management System was implemented in 2018 to obtain UNE-EN ISO 14001 certification, and is based on the following principles:

Waste management. We reduce, reuse and recycle all industrial materials, ensuring pollution prevention and promoting environmental education.

Reduction of water consumption and wastewater treatment.

Energy efficiency.

Our steel suppliers are ISO 14001 certified and use between 80-90% recycled materials.

We have a photovoltaic solar power plant for self-consumption.

70% of our production uses green energy.

More efficient control and management of raw material and finished product warehouses.

The WMS system optimises goods reception, inventory and order preparation, improving efficiency and safety through integration with ERP and the use of DataMatrix codes.

The MES system automates quality control, records incidents and facilitates order preparation, reducing human error and improving production management.

DIGITISATION

The goal is to achieve 0% paper usage by digitising documents using the Docuware platform.
